



DIT Emergency Procedures



Chemical Contamination of Individual

Scene Safety! Alert people in area of danger.
Remove injured person from area of exposure (ONLY IF SAFE).
Otherwise, wait for emergency personnel to arrive.
Dial 999 or 112 for emergency services.

Do not touch the person until they are decontaminated
unless you can safely protect yourself against exposure.
Protective clothing is very important.

Decontamination (**EYES**): Flush with copious amounts of water
at eyewash station/tap water/sterile eye wash for at least **20 mins**.

Decontamination (**SKIN/BODY**): Remove contaminated clothing.
Flush area with copious amounts of water
via emergency shower/tap water for at least **20 mins**.

After decontamination, keep individual warm until arrival
of emergency services. Have ready the product label, the
material safety data sheet (MSDS) for the chemical and
any other critical information.
